Planning of Empowering Girls Ambassador Team for Assistants:

- 1. The initiative is focused on club-level projects through which Rotary Clubs can create positive change in the lives of girls.
- 2. Challenge the clubs to engage in a project or projects of their choices that empowering girls.
- 3. Address the needs & inequalities that girls are facing on a daily basis.
- 4. Implement a project, monitor& measure the impact of the project.
- 5. Disseminate & create awareness of Rotary Resources & Subjects Matters experts (but not limited to) such as Rotarians Action Group, cadres, peace fellows etc.



Planning of Empowering Girls Ambassador Team for Assistants:

- 6. Tell the stories of successful projects and their impact to the general public, using a variety of media channels.
- 7. Share the success stories & their impact across the region and post them on Rotary Showcase, as well as on social media channels.
- 8 . Send a progress report to Ambassador before the RI Board meetings :
 - 1. September 22 (1 or 2 days before)
 - 2. December 16 (at least 1 week before)
 - 3. March 31 (at least 1 week before)
